CAMPD30, CAMPD72 (Carpathian Bellflower) Cup-shaped, upward-facing, 2 in wide, blue-violet flowers. The dark green foliage forms a compact, uniform clump. Tends to bloom a few weeks earlier than other *carpaticas*. 8in/LSp-LSu/Z3-8/30 & 72ct    

Campanula 'Dickson's Gold'
CAMDG30 (Bellflower) Bright gold foliage forms a low growing, dense, weed-suppressing clump. A profusion of lavender blue, star-shaped flowers

Clematis 'Blue Explosion'
CLEBEG1 Incredible bloom power. First round of flowers are semi-double, second round of flowers are single. Large, blue flowers with a hint of pink at the tips. Semi-double & single/5in/May-June & July-Sept/7.5-9ft/Grp2/G1 🌱

Clematis CRATER LAKE ('Mazury')
CLECLG1 This gorgeous double flowered, long blooming selection produces large, periwinkle to soft blue flowers with a small tuft of ivory anthers. Consistent flower form. Double/5-7in/June-Sept/6½-10ft/Grp3/G1 🌱

Clematis EARTHQUAKE ('Bieszczady')

Clematis 'Fujimusume'
